| 1. | Regarding the answer in the clarification part where you are stating that "Six laptops with full software" should be provided. - Question: Please let us know exactly what kind of laptops should they be: - Usual laptops with software for repair manual and spare parts catalogue or - Diagnostic machines (tools), for diagnostics of vehicles or - Combined, one diagnostic machine (station), and 5 (five) laptops with additional software regarding spare parts catalogue and repair manuals. | The required diagnostic tools should be: A combined, one full diagnostic (station), and 5 (five) processing devices to assist in basic diagnostic, including spare parts catalogue and repair manuals. Full diagnostic station is to be located in our Main Transport Workshop and five processing devices are to be located in main transport warehouse and four small regional workshops to enable identification of faulty parts and mutual understanding in process of spare parts purchase and repairs. |

Each vehicle shall be equipped with a spare tire.</p> <p>Question: Is this the requirement only for the tires which they should be already mounted in the vehicle, or is this a request for additional Set of tires beside the ones already mounted in the vehicle?</p> | <p>This requirement refers to tires which should be already mounted in the vehicle.</p> <p>No additional set of tires are requested</p> |
| <p>3.</p> | <p>In the Technical Specification Part of the Requirements, under "Comfort", Point 4, you are asking: 4) Power folding and heated side mirrors.</p> <p>Question: If we offer vehicle with "Manual folding with electrical adjustment and heating mirrors", are we going to be disqualified for this?</p> | <p>Yes. All the technical requirements shall be met.</p> |
| <p>4.</p> | <p>Providing all other specifications are met, ie. engine power, acceleration and fuel consumption, safety features etc. would you accept a bid for a vehicle that had manually folding, electrically heated and adjustable mirrors? This criteria will not affect the overall running costs of the vehicle and would also provide a more cost effective solution should the door mirrors get damaged.</p> | <p>A tender for a vehicle that had manually folding mirrors will be considered as technically non compliant and therefore the bid will be rejected.</p> <p>Tenderers are reminded that the technical requirements are based in the local circumstances and regulations having been the technical requirements carefully analyzed to accommodate said circumstances. Narrow paths and garages are common in the operating area. Consequently mirrors which can be folded without leaving the vehicle are needed.</p> |
