TRIAL IN MITROVICA POSTPONED

Today, a trial involving a panel of three EULEX judges was due to be held at the Mitrovica/ë District Court.

It is a criminal case relating to an alleged serious robbery in October 2007 in the Leposavic/q region. There are two defendants.

The presiding judge has decided to postpone the trial because of strong advice regarding the security situation.

A new date for the start of the trial has not yet been set.
