REGULATION NO. 2004/10

**AMENDING UNMIK REGULATION NO. 2004/2 ON THE DETERRENCE
OF MONEY LAUNDERING AND RELATED CRIMINAL OFFENCES**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

Taking into account United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 1999/1 of 25 July 1999, as amended, on the Authority of the Interim Administration in Kosovo,

Having promulgated UNMIK Regulation No. 2004/2 of 5 February 2004 on the Deterrence of Money Laundering and Related Criminal Offences,

For the purpose of allowing adequate time for the necessary preparation, coordination and training before the entry into force of sections 3-8 of UNMIK Regulation No. 2004/2,

Hereby promulgates the following:

Section 1
Amendments

As of the date on which the present Regulation enters into force UNMIK Regulation No. 2004/2 shall be amended as follows:

- (a) Section 3.21 shall be amended to read:

The present section shall enter into force on 1 September 2004.

(b) Sections 4.10, 5.9, 6.15, 7.6 and 8.5 shall each be amended to read:

The present section shall enter into force on 1 November 2004.

Section 2
Entry into Force

The present Regulation shall enter into force on 29 April 2004.
