**The former text:**

- A description of the organisation of the commercial warranty, as described in Annex II+III covering at least:
  - item 1: three (3) years
  - items 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 18, 19 and 20: one (1) year

in accordance with the conditions laid down in Article 32 of the Special Conditions.

- Duly authorised signature: an official document (statutes, power of attorney, notary statement, etc.) proving that the person who signs on behalf of the company/joint venture/consortium is duly authorised to do so.
- The tenderer shall have a formal “manufacturer’s authorization form” for the items offered.
- Each tenderer is required to provide at no charge to the Contracting Authority a detailed description of the characteristics of the products as required in the technical specifications (Annex II+III) e.g. under the form of a user manuals and Brochures of the product for items 1, 2, 3, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17 and 18. Manuals and Brochures must be submitted in sealed envelope.
